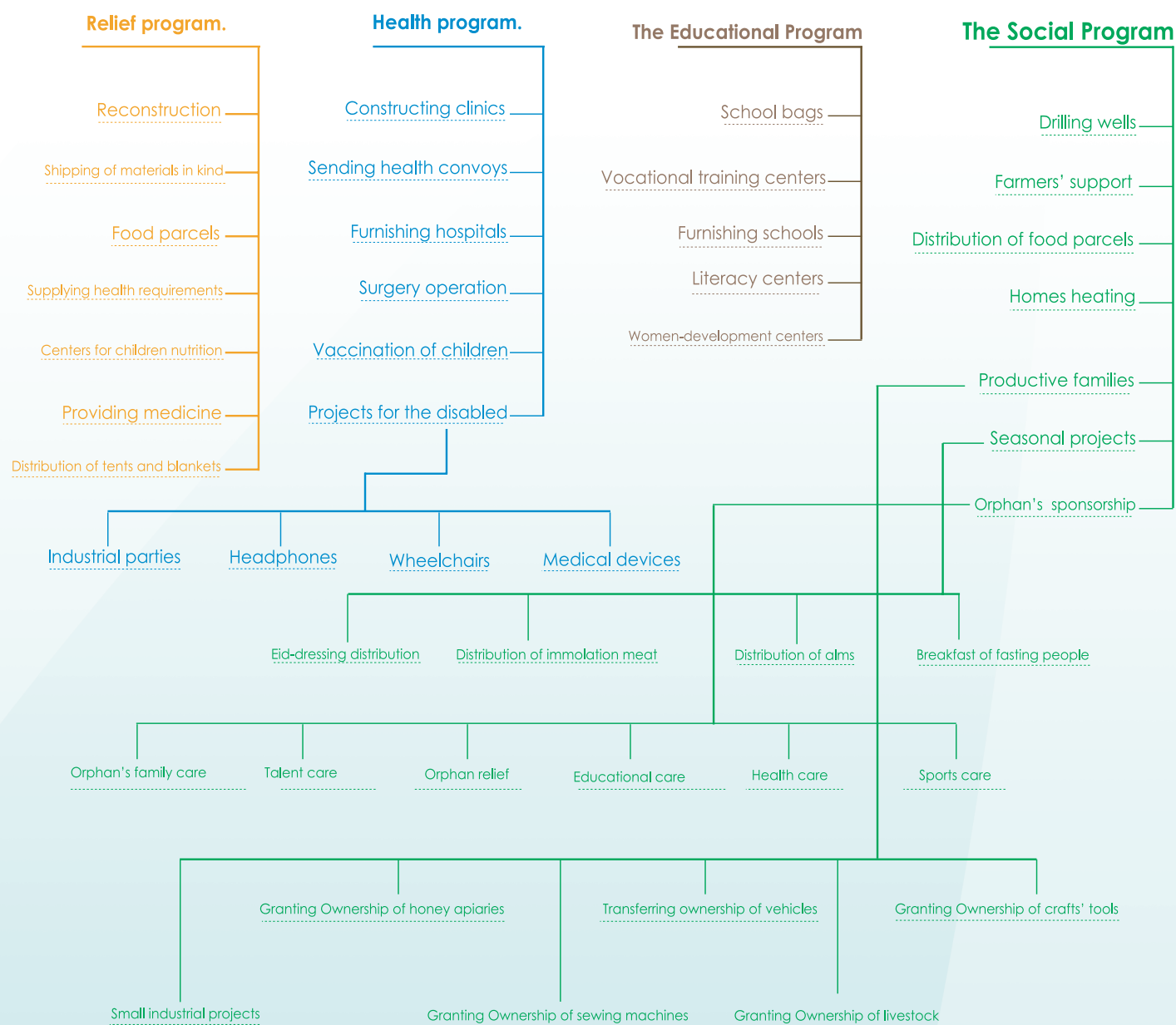

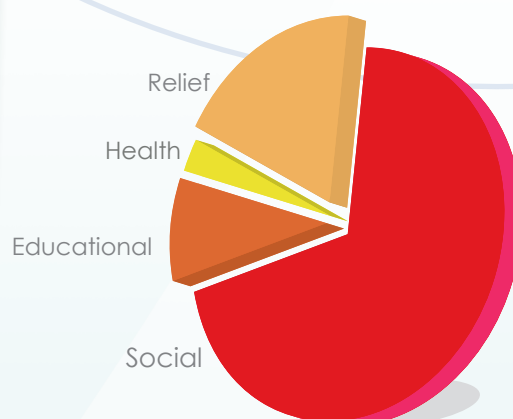

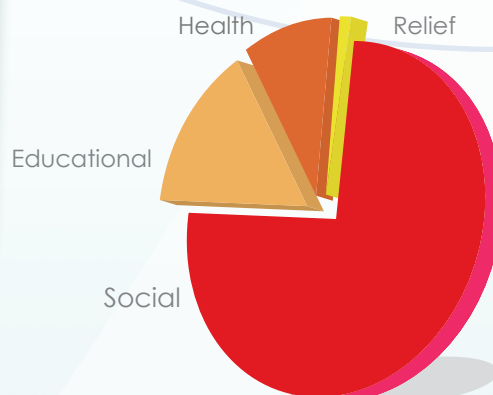

This is carried out by a competent team in field work. The team works on finding the needy social cases to provide a decent life for them. A part from that, it works on contributing actively in financing charitable projects such as: productive families, orphan's care, relief of disaster victims, disabled care and other.

“CREATIVE SPACES” competition.

A distinctive quality of competition founded by women committee. It targets the orphans aged 8 to 18 years in all the offices inside and outside the state. Furthermore, the competition is designed to depart from the usual in providing programs of good quality concerning the charitable volunteering work as well as opening the horizon of charitable work without being restricted to collecting donations. On the contrary, it encourages initiatives and innovation of the orphans. Similarly, it aims at developing the spirit of excellence and scientific research besides creating the spirit of honorable competition between the orphans, showing the hidden talents, enriching their knowledge; added to this, the investment of children's abilities in fruitful work.

Above all, it helps in spreading the culture of creativity through the discovery of talented and distinguished children. Arbitration committee has been appointed to judge the participating works in all areas of literature, art, technology and media. The competition entered its third year on which participation has manifested the progress and sophistication in each year. The orphans' creations appeared to be higher in level and more distinguished in addition to paying more interest in mastering the details. Perhaps the specified conditions and the amount of awards devoted to the winners have led to the vivid level attained by the competition recently.

Since the primary efforts of HAI foundation, orphan sponsorship project has started and achieved great benefits for tens of thousands of orphans whose joy is reflected on their faces. They displayed their invocation of goodness and blessings for the people who sponsored them. Today, many of these orphans have graduated from their schools. They are happy and caring for their families and themselves. Moreover, by the end of 2007, the number of sponsored orphans reached 36.064 orphans distributed over 14 states with a comprehensive care. Thus, the orphan finds a complete custody in all aspects of finance, education, health and social affairs.

ORPHAN RELIEF PROJECT

REHABILITATION AND MAINTENANCE OF WATER STATION IN MOSUL:

As a result of water and electricity deteriorating conditions in Iraq, safe water has become very rare and hardly to be obtained. In addition, supplying houses with water is also rare as a result of the frequent interruption of water supplies. Thus, HAI has rehabilitated and maintained the idle pumps at the station. To add, HAI has not only manufactured all damaged mechanical parts but also it has rehabilitated the electric motors related to it in order to support the on going work of the station to cover the daily needs of the beneficiaries. It has been counted that more than 250,000 citizens have benefited from the project.

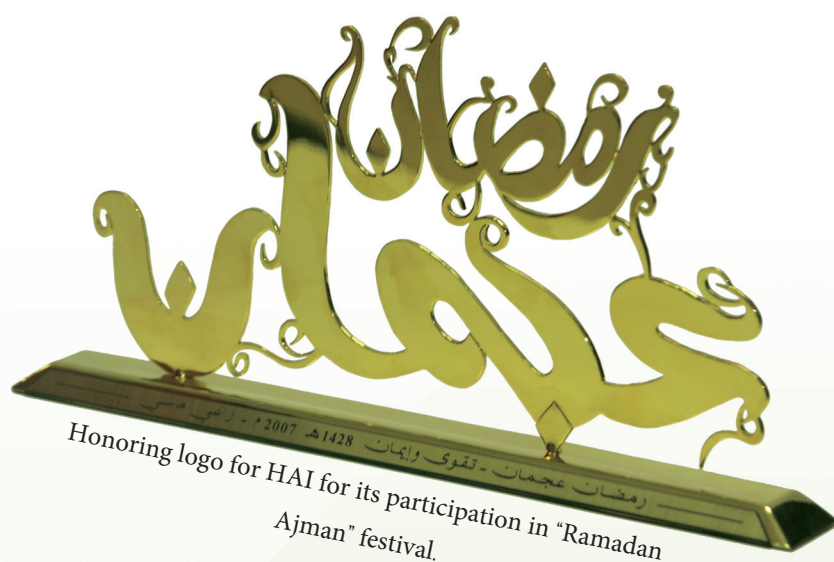
